Exhibitors must tear down their booths after the Continental Breakfast on Tuesday, August 18th. The tradeshow will be closed during all education sessions.

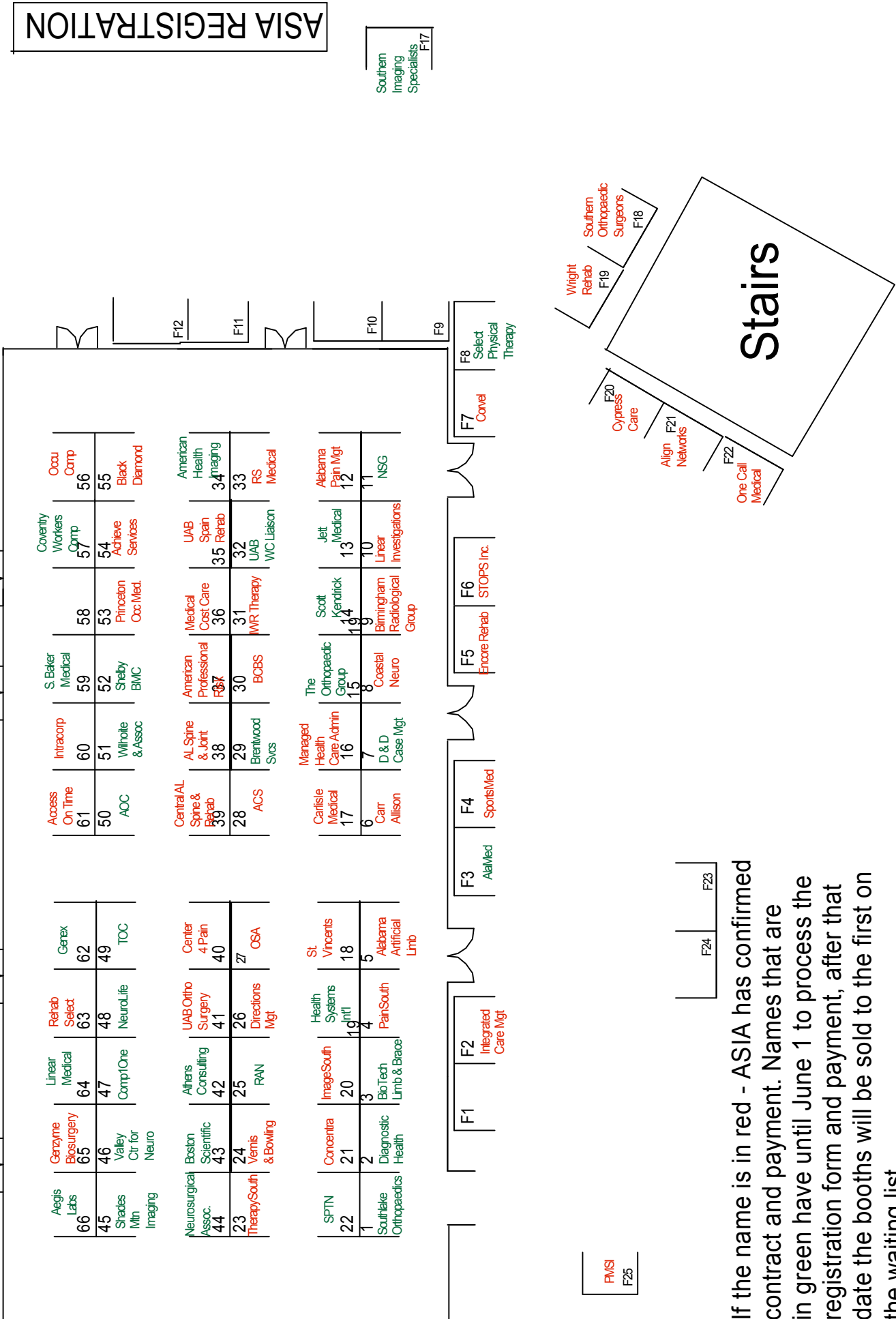
COMP PAC Silent Auction!
